

## Latest COVID updates

April 2022

Latest Government guidelines are as follows:

From the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 the government advise people with symptoms of a respiratory infection, including COVID-19, and a high temperature or who feel unwell, to try stay at home and avoid contact with other people, until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature.

Our Covid Policy:

We would ask all parents/carers to refrain from sending their children to nursery if they have tested positive for COVID-19 or have any of the symptoms. We would advise that your child remains at home for 5 days as this period is the most infectious time for spreading the virus. It will not be necessary to keep your child away from nursery if a member of your family has tested positive, if your child is well and not showing any signs of illness or has not tested positive for the virus.

If your child is unwell and you are not able to carry out a covid test, then please treat as any other childhood illness and keep your child at home until he or she is well enough to attend nursery.
